





Internal view of NS 35 transmitter.

The circuit diagram of both NS 35 versions differed only in the use of directly heated valves (PC 05/15) and indirectly heated valves (PE 05/15).

These transmitter valves were produced in the Philips plant in Warsaw for the German occupying forces and stolen for the Polish Home Army by production employees.
