About this pamphlet.

A slightly rusted dark brown or olive drab Wireless Set No. 19 spare valves case, often without valves or contents, and sometimes containing a deteriorated massive block of petrified sponge rubber, does not keep the eyes for long. Although these die-formed steel boxes are often considered as ubiquitous and only taking space, when I received a number of photographs of an early and rare No. 19 Set Mk.I spare valves case, I examined as a comparison the later and more standardised issued valve cases.

This WftW Pamphlet No. 6 is the result of a survey of the types, versions and variations of the currently known Wireless Set No. 19 spare valves cases, in addition to a small number of associated and related valves cases. It was compiled in collaboration with Chris Bisailion, VE3CBK, Canada. Many of the illustrations in this Pamphlet are from Chris' collection.
