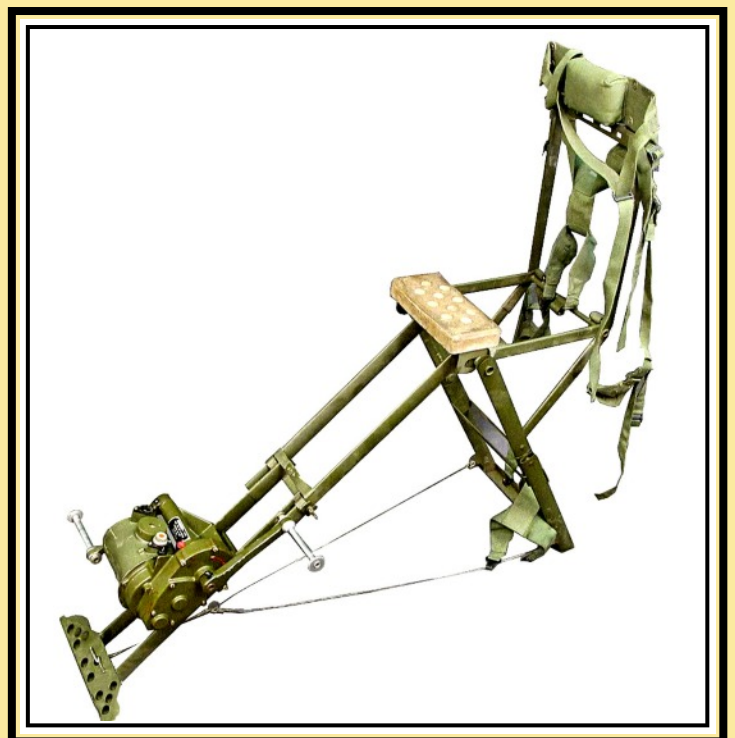

No. 8 Charging Set Pedal Driven 60 Watt



About this publication.

WftW Pamphlet No. 8 is a follow-up of a description of Charging Set, Lightweight, 80 Watt in Pamphlet No. 7. Both charging sets formed the backbone of battery charging for wireless sets used by parachute forces.

Charging Set Pedal Driven 60 Watt was a small, collapsible and lightweight unit designed for charging 12 Volt batteries used with wireless equipment such as Wireless Sets Nos. 22, 62 and 76/R109. It was primary developed for use by parachute and airborne troops. Described in this pamphlet are technical details, tools list, details of the history, difference between types and versions.

Added in the appendices are scans of a Working Instructions Card, scale of stores of a typical WS No. 62 Parachute station and EMERs workshop regulations, in addition to reports relating to de development of the pedal generators.
