## Volume 3 AMENDMENT No. 3

Date of issue: March 2021.
After the publication of 'Wireless for the Warrior' Volume 3 'Reception Sets', a small number of minor (typing) errors and incorrect data was spotted. Corrections, additional photos and newly found items are published in 'Volume 3 Amendments'. If printed on A4 paper, cut away circa 7 mm from the bottom and side of the sheet. The prepared sheets will fit snugly between the inside cover and dust cover flap. It is further recommended (if applicable) to amend the text corrections in the book with e.g. a (red) pencil or a fine-liner.

## Reception Set R209



Bruno Saba, F5CCA, from France, attended me to an error in the components List 209-1 of the Reception Set R209.
'"...This month I made a complete overhaul of one of my R209 Mk2. Nearly all of the resistors and paper capacitors were replaced, most of them being faulty.
After reassembling and powering up, I found the BFO effect was very weak, and the volume control could not go down enough to mute the audio. Clearly the output signal of the BFO was too weak. After looking at the module, I found that I had replaced R50 with a 47k resistor value, according to the list in WftW vol. 3 page R209-9. Looking at a BFO module from another set, I saw it should be 4 k 7 , which was confirmed with a look at the original documentation....'

On Page R209-9, resistor R-50 in BFO plug-in unit should not be 47 k as in the List $209-1$, but 4.7 k .

This is correctly printed in the R209 Mk. 1 circuit diagram on page R209-7, and also in the list of components R209/2/B on page R209-13.
