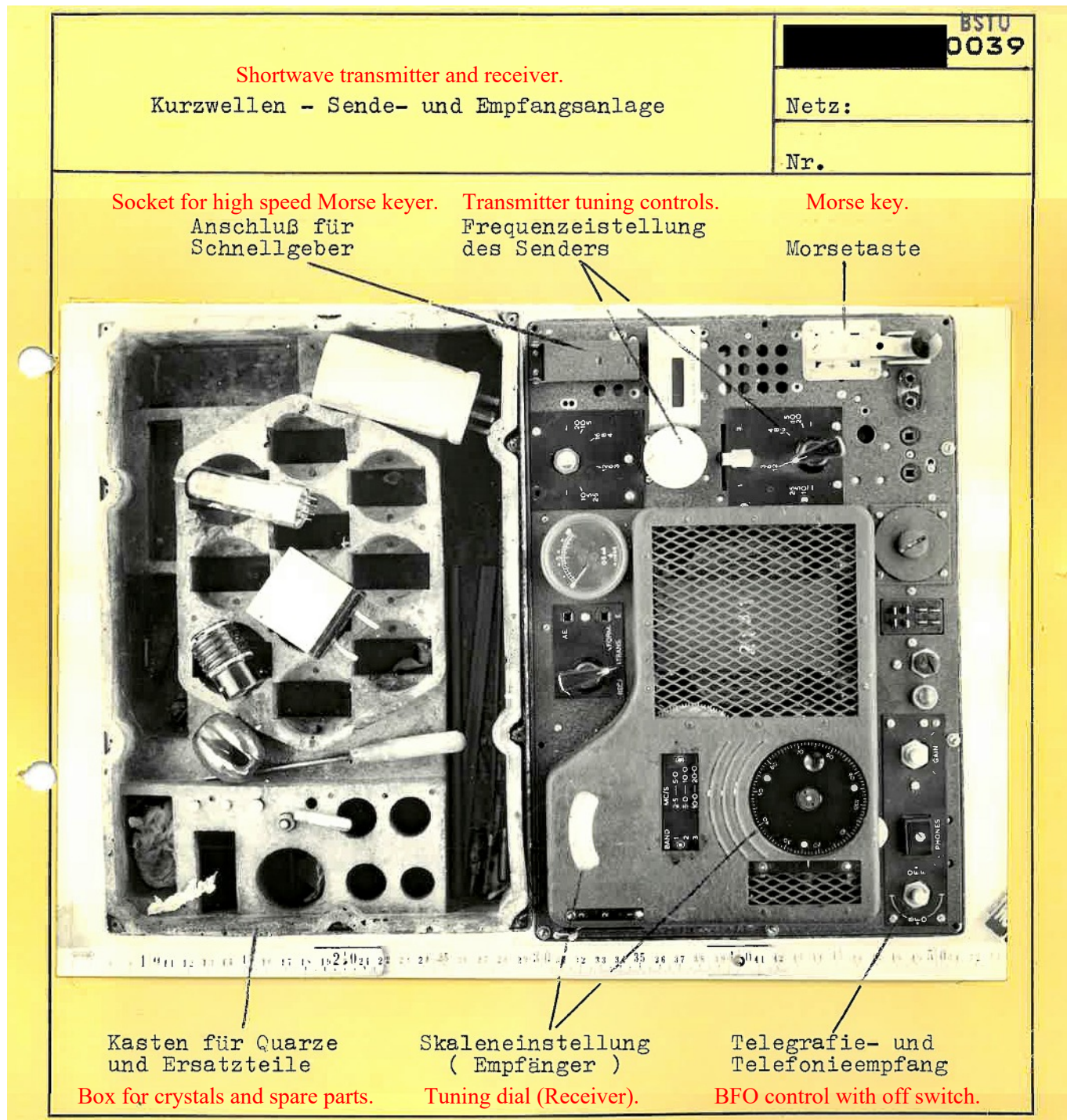


Mk.122 Country of origin: England

WftW Chapter 357 is an addition to the already published information of the British Mk.122. The East German MfS - HA II document above gives very brief data of a captured Mk.122. Unique and never seen before, is its spare parts and crystals box (made from EPE Expanded Polyethylene foam).
